- 1) Unbelievable? With Justin Brierley—An AWESOME podcast featuring long form debates on a myriad of issues relating to Christianity. He frequently has first rate scholars and authors from both sides debate each week.
- 2) I Don't Have Enough Faith to be an Atheist, with Frank Turek--Dr. Turek answers questions and challenges Christians face.
- 3) Str Ask--Listeners tweet their questions for Amy Hall and Greg Koukl, who answer them in 4 minutes or less.
- 4) Biola Apologetics to Islam--A series by the late Nabeel Qureshi, a former Muslim who converted to Christianity as an adult.
